

2020 Swim Lesson Safety Procedures



- No parents will be allowed to remain/spectate from pool deck unless:
 - Child is 3 years and under
 - Special or medical needs
 - Special circumstances approved by the director

Parents that stay on property must wear a mask and social distance

 - Level 1 parents will view lessons from pool deck on Mondays & Thursdays
 - Level 2 parents will view lessons from pool deck on Wednesdays
 - Level 3 parents will view lessons from pool deck on Tuesdays
 - Level 4 parents will view lessons from pool deck on Thursdays
- Please wait in your car until you see your child's instructor (holding a sign). Students will organize and enter the pool area in groups with instructors unless it is your day to view from deck (see above).
- No loitering/socializing on pool deck, cabana area, bathrooms or parking lot
- Remain 6ft apart from other families/students while dropping off and picking up
- Lifeguards and Instructors will wear masks when NOT in the water or on the lifeguard chair (safety hazard and instructional efficiency)
- Students & families should wear a mask while entering/exiting pool area
- Families must leave pool and parking lot promptly after lesson ends (no showering unless it is an emergency)
- No food permitted; personal water bottles are allowed
- Enhanced safety/cleaning/disinfecting policies for staff and instructors
- Registration in lessons/camps/fitness waives all liability to Splash Aquatics, LLC and/or Peppertree Farms

Please note: by participating in our program, you agree to, and understand we will do our best in adhering to social distancing guidelines. We are working with young children and cannot guarantee 6ft distancing at all times while in the water. If you are concerned by this for any reason, we respect your decision to hold off until next year. Please decide what is best for your family. If you do choose to participate, you understand and assume the risks knowing we will be trying our best to provide exceptional swimming instruction in the safest way possible. In return we ask that do your part by keeping sick children or any child that has been directly exposed to ANY illness at home.
